



- That the CORD shall submit the final "Environmental Report" covering the scope of assignment that shall comprise environmental studies (Identification, Prediction and





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




For and on behalf of NHPC Limited (A Govt. of India Enterprise) Bursar HE Project, Kishtwar,

the contract for the aforesaid work is hereby awarded to you on your quoted rates at a total cost of Rs. 41, 80,000/= (Rupees Forty One Lakh & Eighty Thousand Only) as per Annexure- I enclosed and on the terms and conditions mentioned below:

1. This notification of award will constitute the formation of the Contract until the formal Agreement is signed and further subject only to the furnishing of a performance Bank Guarantee of 10% (Ten

Percent) of the Contract sum.

- You shall have to attend the office of undersigned within 15(fifteen) days of issue of Letter of Award along with appropriate non-judicial stamp paper of Rs. 100/= of J&K State for execution of Agreement which will be signed only after the performance Bank Guarantee 10% (Ten Percent) i.e. Rs. 4, 18,000/= only is furnished. The performance Performance Bank Guarantee shall be in the form of Bank Guarantee in favour of NHPC Limited, from an Indian Nationalized / Scheduled Bank of India payable at Kishtwar Code (4596) with in 15(fifteen) days from issue of letter of award valid up to Nov-2016.
- 3. Time for Completion against aforesaid work (as a whole) is 18 (Eighteen) Calendar Months which shall be reckoned w.e.f. date of issuance of letter of award. If you commit default in the commencement of work by the schedule date, the Engineer-in-Charge shall without prejudice to any other right or remedy be at liberty to cancel the Contract.

4. In the event of any typographical error(s) omission(s) found in this Letter of award, the interpretation of General Manager/Sr. Manager (C&C), DPS, Kishtwar based on the original

document shall be binding upon the contractor.

5. Unless exempted, Statutory Taxes will be deducted as per rule as relevant for this work in the State of J&K.

6. For the scope of work, the Terms of Reference (TORs) of EIA & EMP studies as approved by MoEF for Bursar Hydro-Electric Project (as per EIA Notification, 2006 and subsequent amendments), are enclosed herewith. The Consultant shall also be responsible to undertake any other related study "sired by MoEF during the process of EIA & EMP studies and Environmental Clearance.



Clearance of the Project from MoEF, GoI in accordance with the provisions of EIA Notification, 2006, its amendments and procedure / guidelines laid down by MoEF & other Central & State Govt. agencies in this regard from time to time.

- 8. In compliance to the point No. 4(iii) of the MoEF's letter of Prior Environmental Clearance, the EIA & EMP studies of Bursar H. E. Project have been proposed to be taken up considering Dam site at Pakal and surface Power House near Lopara village & another Dam Toe Power House at Pakal (as per Tentative Salient Features enclosed herewith).
- 9. In case of change of any Parameter of the Project like FRL etc. during the process of EIA & EMP studies, no additional payment shall be made to Consultant organization beyond the awarded value. However, in case of change of Dam site or Power House site with change in overall scope of the Project, it shall be decision of Engineer-in-Charge of Bursar H. E. Project.
- 10. The study must conform to the existing standard guidelines read with orders/circulars/policies of Central/ State Government governing such study/ plan issued from time to time.
- 11. The work should be executed in accordance with the directions of Hon'ble Supereme Court and existing rules / guidelines of MoEF in concerned with protected areas / National Park etc.
- 12. Number of Copies each of EIA & EMP Reports & Executive Summary required :-

The Consultant organization carrying out the EIA & EMP studies shall submit following minimum number of copies (original / coloured) of EIA & EMP Reports alongwith Executive summary (in English & Urdu Vernacular language whenever required):-

- iii) Supplementary EIA & EMP Reports (after Public Hearing) :- 05 Sets (if required), on intimation of Engineer -in- Charge of Bursar H. E. Project
- iv) Final EIA & EMP Reports along with Executive Summary (accepted by NHPC):- 25 Sets
- v) Soft copies of EIA & EMP Reports & Executive Summary thereof as mentioned above, shall also be submitted with every revision.
- vi) Any additional copy of above reports, if required, shall be submitted by the Consultant organization, on intimation of Engineer-in-Charge, for which the actual charges may be reimbursed on submission of bill by the Consultant.
- 13. The Consultant Organisation shall provide the following documents within a period of 15 days from the date of issue of this letter of award.
 - i) Valid supporting document/ Certificate w.r.t. accreditation / provisional accreditation with QCI/NABET as per MoEF's scheme
 - ii) Valid document in support of the exemption of taxes / duties to the consultant organization, if any.
 - iii) Copy of other necessary documents like PAN / TIN
 - iv) Copy of any other document as may be requisite & desired by NHPC during the process of Contract
- 14. The travel lodging, boarding or any other expenses for field studies, field surveys, site visits, attending public hearing meetings/meetings with officials of State Pollution Control Board or any other office of the State or Central Govt. etc. during the process of EIA & EMP studies, shall be directly borne by the Consultant Organisation. However, NHPC may provide the accommodation facilities in their Field. Hostels/ Transit Camps/ Guest Houses on the nominal charges, subject to availability. Further, the local transport to the last motorable point of the Project site, for field surveys, may be provided by NHPC, as per availability.
- 15. Copy of insurance policy covering the labourers / workmen (engaged if any) for the above work be produced to the Engineer-in-charge.

This Agreement is executed on this the 23 -10 -, 2014 at Srinagar by and between Government of Jammu and Kashmir through Chief Executive Officer, Sonamarg Development Authority (Tourism and Culture Department, Civil Secretariat, Srinagar), hereinafter referred to as the "as party No 1"

And

The University of Kashmir through its Coordinator, EIA Projects, and Centre of Research for Development hereinafter referred to as "as party No. 2"

Whereas the Government desires to entrust the project work relating to "Preparation of "Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA)" to the Center of Research for Development, University of Kashmir within the allotted amount of Rs.27.50 Lakh.

Whereas both parties mutually agree to undertake the work on the following terms and conditions:-

 - d. The final project report shall present the specific project proposal for implementing EIA amongst other things, the information on:-
 - I. Geological and Geophysical Aspects:
 - Geography & physiographic of the project area.
 - Regional Geology and structure of the project area and its surroundings.
 - Seismic status of the area.
 - Elements of Tourist Attraction.
 - Climate of the area
 - Remote Sensing Studies of the Direct and Indirect Impact Zones. II.
 - Land use and land cover mapping.
 - Drainage pattern/ map.
 - Geophysical features, slope and relief
 - Status of Forest Cover
 - Classification of Build-up Land Use with special reference to Distribution Pattern of Existing Tourist Infrastructure Amenities
 - III. Biological Resources of the Areas
 - a. Flora and Fauna
